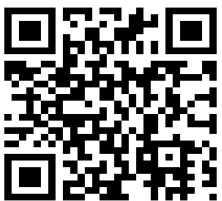

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## Bangladesh Film Archives celebrates 40 years Founding Anniversary

**A** day-long programme of forty years Founding Anniversary of Bangladesh Film Archives(BFA) inaugurated by Information Minister Mr Hasanul Haq Inu, MP, while Director General (DG) of the Film Archive Sachindra Nath Halder and Secretary of Information Ministry Abdul Malek were present at the opening ceremony as special guests on 17 May 2018.

The event was started by a screening of Bengali film *Debdas* at level one, projection Hall of BFA. This film was made in 1935 directed by Pramathesh Barua

As part of the celebration, digital footage from Zahir Raihan's incomplete film 'Let There be Light' was screened at the said projection Hall. French film 'Incident at Owl Creek' directed by Robert Enrico was also screened at the programme.

Besides, a seminar titled 'Bangladesh Film Archive: the forty-year journey' was held on the day to mark the founding anniversary in the afternoon. Expert faculty, researcher and writer on Film Affairs Mr Anupam Hayat presented keynote paper, while Amzad Hossain, Morshedul Islam and Jahangir Hossain discussed on the topic.

This session was presided over by DG of BFA Shachindra Nath Halder

The day-long programme also featured an exhibition on the poster and photographs of popular yesteryear films like 'Jiban Theke Neya', 'Arunodoyer Agnisakkhi', 'Moynamoti', 'Sareng Bou', 'Chashi Meye', 'Chitra Nodir Parey', 'Matir Moyna' and others.

Filmmaker Morshedul Islam, Syed Salahuddin Zaki, actress Anjana, Rozina and Shah-nur among others were present at the programme. The programme was ended by following an Iftar

# Workshop on “Concept and Uses of UGC Digital Library (UDL) and Open Access Online Resources” held at Primeasia University Central Library

Primeasia University Central Library organised a workshop on “Concept and Uses of UGC Digital Library (UDL) and Open Access Online Resources”. The said workshop was held on 12 May 2018 for the Microbiology department, 15 May 2018 for the Pharmacy department, 16 May 2018 for the Biochemistry department and 22 May 2018 for Computer Science and Engineering department respectively, at its Banani campus in Dhaka of the incumbent year. The workshop was designated for the members of the faculty, served as a guide about the UDL and Open Access Online Resources and how these resources can be used methodically. Ms Shagufta Hussain, Librarian in charge of the university, chaired all the sessions. She said, **“Most of the faculty members are unaware of the procedure to**

**retrieve e-resources from the Ocean. When they write an article or lecture in class, quoting a reference becomes time-consuming and tedious. We arranged a short training program where we incorporated the use of different search engines and Boolean search method to aid in the extraction of the desired resource. I hope it will be beneficial for the faculty members of our university. We look forward to arranging similar workshops which will be even more inclusive and comprise of the faculty, students and staff of all the major departments of the university.”**

Most of the participants in the workshop were very much enthusiastic to learn, and they uttered that this training would be beneficial and it will assist

in their academic and research projects. Some faculty members stated, **“Before the workshop, we were unaware of the volume of information available in the open access format. It is astounding how the library has made such vast amounts of information easily accessible to us over the internet! The workshop was truly useful.”**

Library officers, Mr Uttam K. Roy and Ms Afroza Sultana, conducted the said series of workshop in coordination with the library staff Asst. Librarian Amit Kumer Dey, Junior Asst. Librarian Khandokar Kulsum Akter, Jebunnesa, Lina Rashid, Library Officer Saiduz-zaman and Razia Sultana.

**F**our Day Long Faculty Orientation and Development Workshop Program was held at Faculty Lounge (Level 5, Admin Building) and Computer LAB 611 (Library Building 6th floor), where library played a significant role to introduce and demonstrate the Library Service and Research Support Tools.

**Day-1:** University Librarian, Dr Zahid Hossain Shoeb briefly highlighted the importance of Research Support Programmes. He also facilitated to the new faculty members for creating Authors Profile and Researchers ID Registration to different research media, like Google Scholar, ResearchGate, Orcid, Scopus, Mendeley and Publonsetc by hands-on demonstration.

**Day-2:** Senior Assistant Librarian, Mr M M Shoeb demonstrated on Library Services, Functions, Membership, OPAC Search and Book Requisition Processes. He also briefly introduced to the Grammar checking tool - 'Grammarly'. Senior IT Officer, Mr Rajiv Mahmud introduced to the NSU subscribed online resources and plagiarism checking tools 'Turnitin'. Assistant Librarian, Mr Abdul Hakim, showed how to issue and return books by using Self Checking Machine. He also arranged a physical tour of NSU Central Library for the new Faculty Members.

**Day-3:** University Librarian, Dr Zahid Hossain Shoeb, demonstrated on citation tools 'Mendeley', and Senior IT Officer, Mr Rajiv Mahmud introduced to the abstract and citation database 'Scopus'.



**N**orth South University (NSU) Library and Office of the Graduate Studies jointly organised a workshop, titled "Following the Research Workflow Using Scopus and Mendeley" on 24 April 2018, at 2.00pm at AUDI 801, NSU. Internet Archive has received a \$1 million dollar grant from Arcadia – a charitable fund of Lisbet Rausing and Peter Baldwin – to digitize titles from university press collections to make them available via controlled digital lending. The project, *Unlocking University Press Books*, will bring more than 15,000 titles online from university presses. This project extends the successful pilot with MIT Press, which has already made more than 400 books available for digital learners around the world.
